

Enrolments

Enrolled users are users who fully participate in a course. It is important to remember that roles and enrolments are separate, although an enrolled user will have a role within the context of the course. It is possible to have access but not be enrolled.





Enrolment API

- The Enrolment API defines both the enrol_plugin abstract class that all enrolment plugins extend and several general enrolment functions. It is defined in the //ib/enrollib.php file.

Enrolment API (cont)

Plugin-Specific functions

- enrol_get_plugins() returns all the enrolments plugins, optionally only enabled ones
- enrol_get_plugin() returns an instance of a plugin's class, as opposed to instances of the enrolments methods as below
- enrol_get_instances() returns the instances in a particular course. For some enrolment plugins it is possible to add multiple instances, especially in cases where each of the instances has a different setting
- enrol_is_enabled() checks if a particular enrolment plugin is enabled





Enrolment API (cont)

User-Specific

- enrol_get_my_courses() lists courses current user is enrolled in
- enrol_get_users_courses() lists courses a particular user is enrolled in
- is_enrolled() checks of the user is enrolled in the course
- get_enrolled_users(), count_enrolled_users(), and enrol_get_course_users() gets user information for a course
- get_enrolled_with_capabilities_join(), get_enrolled_sql(), and get_enrolled_join() - returns SQL snippets to be used to extract enrolment data for developers
