



# Module Features

- FEATURE\_ADVANCED\_GRADING – true if the module supports advanced grading methods
- FEATURE\_BACKUP\_MOODLE2 – true if the module supports backup/restore for the moodle2 format
- FEATURE\_COMPLETION\_HAS\_RULES – true if the module has custom completion rules
- FEATURE\_COMPLETION\_TRACKS\_VIEWS – true if the module has code to track whether somebody has viewed it
- FEATURE\_CONTROLS\_GRADE\_VISIBILITY – true if the module controls the grade visibility over the grade book
- FEATURE\_GRADE\_HAS\_GRADE – true if the module can provide a grade
- FEATURE\_GRADE\_OUTCOMES – true if the module supports outcomes
- FEATURE\_GROUPINGS – true if the module supports groupings
- FEATURE\_GROUPS – true if the module supports groups





# Module Features (cont)

- FEATURE\_IDNUMBER – true (which is the default) if the module wants support for setting the ID (the number for grade calculation purposes)
- FEATURE\_MOD\_ARCHETYPE – type of module
- FEATURE\_MOD\_INTRO – true if the module supports intro editor
- FEATURE\_MODEDIT\_DEFAULT\_COMPLETION – true if the module has default completion
- FEATURE\_NO\_VIEW\_LINK – true if the module has no 'view' page (like label)
- FEATURE\_PLAGIARISM – true if the module supports plagiarism plugins
- FEATURE\_SHOW\_DESCRIPTION – true if the module can show description on the course's main page
- FEATUREUSESQUESTIONS – true if the module uses the question bank





# FEATURE\_MOD\_ARCHETYPE

Firstly, we want Moodle to know that we are a resource, so we need to return the relevant response for the `FEATURE_MOD_ARCHETYPE` feature. There are four defined responses for the feature, which are also defined in the `lib/moodlelib.php` file:

- `MOD_ARCHETYPE_ASSIGNMENT` – assignment module archetype
- `MOD_ARCHETYPE_OTHER` – unspecified module archetype
- `MOD_ARCHETYPE_RESOURCE` – resource-like type module
- `MOD_ARCHETYPE_SYSTEM` – system (not user-addable) module archetype

The last one is obviously for internal Moodle use. In our case, we return `MOD_ARCHETYPE_RESOURCE`.
